# MacKenzie House Museum & Library Update

Patriotism was alive and well in May at the MacKenzie Museum. Donna Terkildsen had the pump organ joyfully playing historic patriotic songs. Many guests enjoyed the music and sang along. You may not have noticed, but our local cemeteries were all visited by volunteers in Monmouth County to place flags on every veteran. Many Howell Twp. organizations participated in the Farmingdale Memorial Day Parade, where the streets were lined with excited watchers.

There are more upcoming events planned for MacKenzie that continue to focus on the Patriotic Theme. As you know, June 14<sup>th</sup> is Flag Day and America will be celebrating the 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the U.S. Army Grand Military Parade. On June 21, guests at MacKenzie Museum will focus on Our Grand Old Flag, and we will honor our veterans and troops by displaying military flags.

In May, Donna shared the "Grand Old Flag" story, and we sang the words. But, the background story was a bit of a surprise. "You're a Grand Old Flag" was written by George M. Cohan for his 1906 stage musical *George Washington, Jr.* The original lyric, as Cohen later explained, came from an encounter he had with a Civil War veteran who fought at Gettysburg. The two men found themselves next to each other and Cohan noticed the veteran held a carefully folded but ragged old flag. The man reportedly, turned to Cohan and said, "She's a grand old rag." Cohan thought it was a great line and originally named his tune, "You're a Grand Old Rag." Many people objected to calling the flag a "rag", so Cohan renamed the song, "You're a Grand Old Flag."

We hope you'll join us June 21<sup>st</sup> as we honor "Our Grand Old Flag." In July, we will look back at the Revolutionary War Period with a focus on our veterans, and 1776 flags.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Jude Meehan Flag salute and moment of silence by Jude Meehan

#### **Business Meeting:**

**Prior Meeting Minutes**: The minutes of the April 25th 2025 meeting of HHHS could not be approved as posted in the HHHS PasTimes May 2025 Newsletter pg. 6 Library. Leigh distributed copies of a correction. The agreement referred to in the minutes was between the Howell Historical Society and The Howell Township over 50 years ago. That agreement became null and void 9/24/19. The new resolution of the Township of Howell authorizing the sale of Block 47 Lot 23 to HHHS reads "For the purpose of restoration, preservation, improvement and utilization of the historical site for the benefit of the general public". #### **Committee Reports:**

**Finance**: There has been no update on the previous account.

**<u>Fundraising</u>**: Margaret said that Ellen got a date from Woody's, August 23rd, for the cornhole event. There is a 2 1/2-hour time frame. Chris will do the set-up and be an impartial judge. The charge is \$100. There will be a lunch meeting if anyone would like to join them.

December fundraiser: Leigh spoke to the secretary at Farmingdale UMC but needs to speak to the pastor. HHHS and Farmingdale Historical Society both agreed to take on refreshments.

Larry asked for volunteers for the yard sale.

MacKenzie House: Jude is looking into help for a water supply for the house. Leigh offered to write a letter to Donna's son concerning the work he is doing and confirmed that our cost would be \$1500. Donna's son would absorb any other costs. Leigh suggested a motion to approve the cost. Jude offered to take away anything that needs to be moved for the project. Jude motioned to approve the \$1500 cost. Catherine 2nd. All were in favor.

<u>Old Ardena School:</u> A flea market was planned for June 7th 2025. Margaret confirmed that the schoolhouse would not be open the last Sunday in May.

# HHHS MEETING MINUTES – MAY 23, 2025 SUBMITTED BY: HHHS SECRETARY, DEBORAH FROST

<u>Library:</u> Lynn said she and Ann M met twice within the last 3 weeks. She learned so much from Ann. Lynn spoke about a plan for the format, function, purposes and inventory. She thanked Margaret for typing information into a format. Lynn and Ann are developing a clear library concept that will be helpful in maintaining inventory and references. There will be rules for usage and sign outs. It will not be a lending library. If they wanted to display something interesting they found, they could inform the docents. Library dates could be set, and it could be publicized when they would be there. A genealogy program could be developed. Mini lessons, displays, and a book club were mentioned as possibilities. Ann said the Howell Boosters are very fragile and could tear. They are unique to Howell and she suggested that we should have white gloves. She showed one volume to the Monmouth County Archives. It would cost \$3400 to digitize the volumes and \$4000 to put them on the internet. Another option is to donate the set to the Monmouth County Archives where they would be on a waiting list after a deed book is completed. Jude was in favor of the 2nd option, asked if that is what we wanted to do, and asked for comments from the group.

Donna preferred doing 1/2 first. Ann said donated items would be climate controlled. Leigh said people loved to look at the books and that we have been careful with these items. Frank wondered about damage. Jude asked Lynn if she thought they would be a draw to Mackenzie house and asked if they would ever come back once they were gone. Bob wondered where we would look at the digitized books. Margaret asked what would we do to preserve the books if they stayed. Lynn said newsprint is fragile. Ann said they (newsprint) were made to disintegrate. Frank asked if we could take one issue and scan it and then donate the books. Ellen loves the Boosters and supports the digitized form and donation option. Lynn wondered if we could try to copy one or try to copy some ads. Margaret said that when using a standard printer, those copies would fade. Jude thought funds would have to come from another source if we did the digitalization.

Jude, speaking as a member, not a president, wanted Mackenzie to be a Miller's historic home in Howell on the weekend. If docents wanted to display items, it's up to them. He is not against library days, but on tour days.... Frank expressed reservations about leaving fragile items out. Lynn said people could be invited to come in on a different day other than a tour day. Jude asked for feedback. Leigh said the chairs can all be sat on. Children have been well behaved, and they are allowed to touch certain things. She wants people to feel like they can touch things, sit down and be comfortable.
